STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Western Australian law stipulates that all school-aged children must go to and attend school every day. The Department of Education has an expectation that every student will have an attendance rate of 90% or higher. During the pandemic our attendance rate dropped significantly. This year there will be close monitoring of every student's attendance rate to ensure they are meeting the Department expectation. Parents must provide a reasonable cause if their child is absent from school. To do this, parents log onto Compass and complete the attendance section with the reason for your child's absence. If your child is unwell please add some detail e.g., Billy is absent from school with a temperature and flu symptoms. Absences for in -term holidays, birthdays, feeling tired, hair appointments etc. are not considered reasonable causes for absence.

If you have any concerns about your child's attendance please speak to their teacher.

CLASSROOM DOORS OPEN

Our classroom doors open at 8:15am and this is the time we would like your children to be at school and in their classes ready to start the day. When your children arrive at 8:15am they greet their teacher at the door and enter the classroom to prepare for their learning. This gives them 15 minutes to become settled and they are ready to learn when the music starts at 8:30am. Please support your children to be calm and ready to do their personal best.

END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Our school day ends at 2:45pm. Students in Kindy and Pre-Primary must be picked up by an adult at the classroom door. Students in years 1-6 will be dismissed by the classroom teacher.

It is important that students who are collected by parents or carers are picked up at 2:45pm. Our staff have meetings and planning to do after school and cannot be expected to supervise your children after school pick up time.

In the case of an emergency and you are going to be late please contact the office by 2:30pm to allow our office staff time to get the message to your child's teacher.

If you are unable to pick your child up at 2:45pm every day we have Camp Australia on site to provide before and after school care. The rates are subsidised and Andy and his team provide an exceptional program. Call into the front office for more information.

OUR PLAYGROUNDS

For duty of care reasons, we do not allow students to play on our playgrounds or with our outdoor learning resources before or after school. Students must be with a parent if they arrive at school between 8:00 – 8:15am and we ask you do not allow them to run around the playground or play on the equipment during this time. This will ensure our students are settled and ready to enter the classroom calmly at 8:15am.

OUR OVAL

Unfortunately, our oval is under repair and will not be in use for term 1. We are working with the Department to rectify the issues and we hope that our oval will be healthy and ready to go in term 2. In the meantime, we have roped the oval off to prevent people from using it.

Students will be able to use the area at the back of the school where the yarning circle and bushtucker garden are located.



KISS AND DRIVE

Following the work from the Council we now have Kiss and Drive zones at the front and the back of the school. To ensure the safety of our students, staff, parents, and community we ask you follow the Kiss and Drive rules, be patient and demonstrate respect at all times when using these zones.

Please remember the following rules when using this area –

1. DRIVERS DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE

To assist with traffic flow in the Kiss and Drive zone, drivers are to remain in the car while the children get in and out. To facilitate this, children should travel with bags in the car and not in the boot. If a driver must get out, they MUST NOT move more than 3 metres from their vehicle.

2. BE TIMELY

If your child does not enter or exit the vehicle within 2 minutes you are required to travel around the block and re-enter the zone at the end of the queue.

3. KERB SIDE ENTRY/EXIT

Ensure your child enters/exits the vehicle on the kerb side. Ensure your child has their restraint securely fastened before moving off from the Kiss and Drive zone.

4. STAY IN SEQUENCE

Please queue in an orderly manner. Drop/pick-up your child as close as you can to the top of the zone allowing vehicles following you to enter the designated area. Wait patiently for the cars in front of you to leave, rather than pulling out behind them.

5. BE PATIENT - SAFETY MUST COME FIRST.

Please wait patiently for the cars in front of you to leave the area before you leave.
