Dear parents and carers

'Every minute, of every school day counts. '

Every day that a student does not attend school can have a negative impact on their learning. To ensure every student is able to experience success with their learning, students are expected to have a regular attendance rate of 90% or more.

Since 2020 we have seen a big change in our school's regular attendance rate. Pre-Covid our regular attendance rate was 86.7% and we saw this drop as low as 52.6% in the midst of Covid. This semester our regular attendance rate is 66.1% which is below that of 'like' and 'WA Public' schools and is considerably lower than the expected 90% or above.

In our new Business Plan 2024-2027 we will be focusing on working with our families and students to increase our regular attendance rate to at least 90% or above.

We understand that absences due to illness, injury or family emergencies are unavoidable however we are requesting that families refrain from taking their children out of school for holidays or any reason, other than illness, injury, specialist appointments or emergencies, during the school term to ensure your child experiences success with their learning.

The table below sets out how much equivalent school is missed through non-attendance.
